EYE EXAMINATIONS

Eyesight is perhaps the most precious of the five senses, so why is caring for our eyes so often at the bottom of our healthcare list? Regular eye examinations should be as much a part of your family's routine as a visit to the dentist.

CONTACT LENSES

Have you ever considered contact lenses? Now is the time to try contact lenses, because new technology has created a range of lenses to suit everyone, even those who have previously been told their eyes are unsuited to them.

CHILDRENS EYES

Eye development between birth and seven years is crucial: undetected problems during that period can result in lifelong visual impairments.

Many children have undetected sight problems. Research shows that approximately 1 in 10 Year 8 children (12-13 year-olds) and 1 in 20 Year 2 children (6-7 year-olds) require glasses but do not have them. Uncorrected eye problems can seriously damage not only the development of a child's vision but also their social interaction and performance at school. The negative consequences can be far-reaching.

Most patients wear the lenses overnight and remove them on awakening. Ortho K provides the opportunity to be free from both contact lenses and spectacles for all waking hours. Ortho K is particularly suited to children, sportsmen and people who work in dusty and dry environments.
